
Greater Richmond, Virginia Labor Shed


Businesses in the Richmond, Virginia metro area draw labor from 38 counties in central Virginia – an area with 2.2 million population and a workforce of 1.1 million.

The primary labor shed is the 17 counties in the Richmond MSA, which has 1.3 million population and a workforce of 654,000. The secondary labor shed includes 21 counties with 917,000 population and a workforce of 473,000; at least 500 residents of each of these county's work in the Richmond MSA.

The region's population has increased by 9 percent since 2011, adding over 18,500 additional residents annually.
